Story Homes now have detailed planning permission for the development of 240 homes on the former hospital land. In January they started site preparation for phases one and two of this development – at the Elm Park end of the site. While construction traffic is using the Woodlands

While construction traffic is using the Woodlands Road/Queens Road entrance to the site, eventual access for the houses will be from Elm Park. They anticipate that the first properties will be on sale in May this year.

The remainder of the land is also being managed by Story Homes, with further phases expected to be built over the next 7/8 years.
